MOSCOW

- Red Square It is rich in symbols of Russia's turbulent and intriguing past, it has been for centuries, the heart and soul of Russia. The square's name it derives from the word 'krasnyi', which once meant 'beautiful' and has only come to mean 'red' in contemporary.
- St Basil's Cathedral It is an Orthodox church on the Red Square in Moscow. It's interior and exterior as its architectural style is unique and constitues the icon of the city. It was built of the Khanate of Kazan and declared as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1990s, along with the entire Kremlin.
- Lenin Mausoleum which the mummified body of Lenin is still preserved, has become one of Moscow's main attraction.
- **Kremlin** The name Kremlin means "fortress inside a city". It is a fortified complex at the heart of Moscow, overlooking the Moskva River to the south, St Basil's Cathedral and Red Square to the east and the Alexander Garden to the west. It is the best know of the kremlins (Russian Citadels) and includes five palaces, four cathedrals and the enclosing Kremlin Wall with Kremlin towers.

SERGIEV POSAD (GOLDEN RING TOWN)

- Sergiev Posad It is a city in North Moscow Oblast, which is famous for its Troitse-Sergiev Monastery, the spiritual home of the Russian Orthodox Chruch. It is offen visited as a part of the Golden Ring around Moscow. This town is alos well known for making dolls and other toys since ancient times.
- St. Trinity Cathedral Sergiev Posad Is a town situated 70 km from Moscow. In the monastery area there are three cathedrals: St Trinity Cathedral, Assumption Cathedral and Refectory. The oldest cathedral, St Trinity Cathedral, built in 1422 1423 over the tomb of St Sergey, it declared as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1993s.

MURMANSK

- **Saami Village** Dive into the fabulous atmosphere of the Sami World. Here, you will not only to know fascinating and exciting information about the traditional lifestyle of Sami but also get vivid emotions and memories that will forever leave a mark in your heart. You can taste Sami cuisine, feed the reindeer and husky dog, photo session in national Sami costumes, reindeer and snow-moble sledging ride.
- Nuclear-Powered Icebreaker "Lenin" The first surface ship with nuclear propulsion, Icebreaker was built in the Soviet Union, first and foremost to serve the Northern Sea Route. The Icebreaker "Lenin" in 1989 was decommissioned and put on external parking in Murmansk.
- **Snow Village** One of the most highlight in Murmansk, it is a unique complex in more ways than one. Built entirely out of snow and ice, it has been erected every winter in Kirovsk. Each year, more than 20 halls of the facility are re-erected with a new design theme.

MURMANSK

- Teriberka An amazing place in the Northern part of the Kola Peninsula. Here you can see firsthand the unfrozen shore of the Arctic ocean, snow-covered endless expanses of the Arctic tundra, a sandy beach in the middle of snowdrifts and the polar sun.
- Aurora Borealis Hunting The Aurora Borealis is a beautiful and mysterious natural phenomenon that occurs when solar winds interact with the Earth's magnetic field, causing hit-energy electrons and ions to enter the Earth's atmosphere and collide with gas molecules, releasing energy and producing brilliant lights. The best season to hunt for the Northern Lights is from Sep till Apr with the most frequent sightings occurring between 6pm to 1am.

The opportunity to witness this visual wonder of nature, it is subjected on weather conditions such as solar activity, cloud cover and other factors and cannot be guaranteed. However, sighting is not confined to this schedule as the "dancing green lights" may show up randomly during your stay in Arctic Circle.

ST PETERSBURG

- Peterhof Palace known as the "Russian Versailles", which consists of a series of palaces and gardens that were the residence of the czars. The beautiful Peterhof Palace is a series of palaces and gardens just outside of town, majestic and covered in gold, is often referred to as the "Russian Versailles". Golden Grand Cascade, a steep fall of 64 gilded fountains flowing in front of the Grand Palace.
- The Peter and Paul Fortress It is the original citadel of St Petersburg, Russia, founded by Peter the Great in 1703 and built to Domenico Trezzini's designs from 1706 to 1740. In the early 1920s, it was still used as a prison and execution ground by the bolshevik government. Today it has been adapted as the central and the most important part of the State Museum of Saint Petersburg history. The museum has gradually become virtually the sole owner of the fortress building, except the structure occupied by the Saint Petersburg Mint.
- Church of the Savior on Spilled Blood Church of our Savior on Spilled Blood also known as Cathedral of the Resurrection of Christ.
 Construction began in 1883 during the reign of Alexander III, 2 years after the assassination of his father Alexander. The avior on Blood harks back to medieval Russian architecture in the spirit of romantic nationalism.
